Harendra-Chitra College, Bhaktardaba (affiliated by Gauhati University) began life as an institution of higher education from 1992-93 under Barpeta District Located centrally in wide area which accommodates 3 (Three) Mauzas- Paka Mauza, Betbari Mauza and Sarukhetri Mauza under Barpeta District. With a view to established this college a Governing Body was formed headed by Mr. Mukaddes Ali Ahmed as President and Mr. Muksed Ali Ahmed as Secretary consisting 35 Members of different places. The Deshbhakta Rural Development Association a prominent NGO of our area first organized a meeting to establish a college and accordingly presided over by Mr. Elim Uddin Khan (B.A., B.T.) Headmaster, Paschim Paka Azad Memorial High School. The first land donated by Mr. Fazar Ali, S/O- Late Taher Ali, Nali Gaon to open the College.

Mr. Sirajul Hoque, Advocate, Barpeta & Ex MLA of Sarukhetri has the vital role in connection with the contribution of Mr. Harendra Nath Das and Mrs. Chitra Bala Das of Barpeta, with the college authority must have to recollect contribution of Mr. Ismail Hussain then Minister, Govt. of Assam & Chairman of Barpeta LAC and Deputy Commissioner Mr. Alok Kumer, I.A.S. then Deputy Commissioner of Barpeta District and now chief secretary, Govt. of assam.

ADMISSION PROCEDURE

Application for admission into the courses begin with the notification issued by the Principal immediately after the announcement of respective results. Prospectus for admission can be obtained from the College Office on payment of the prescribed fee and the intending candidates are required to submit the completed Application Forms within prescribed time limit. Application are processed and finalized by the Admission Committee.

ELIGIBILITY NORMS

The eligibility norms for submission of applications for admission are as follows: **B.A. Semester (Arts)**: H.S. in concerned stream or equivalent recognized examination with at least 40% marks in aggregate for General Course and at least 45% marks in aggregate for Major Course.

DOCUMENTS OF ADMISSION

Admission forms enclosed must be completed and submitted with prescribed time along with the following:

- i) Attested copies of all Certificates, Mark sheets and Registration Certificate of H.S.
- ii) Pass and Character Certificate from the head of institution attended last.
- iii) H.S.L.C. Admit Card for verification of age.
- iv) Certificate for SC/ST/OBC/MOBC/PH/OSP.
- v) Gap Certificate from a competent authority, if required.
- vi) Recent black and white passport size photograph.
- Vii) Income certificate provided by circle officer

REGISTRATION AND MIGRATION

Registration is compulsory for all students on submission of prescribed forms. After admission under GU and students from universities other then GU shall have to produce Migration Certificate at the time of admission.

ATTENDANCE

Attendance is compulsory in all classes. Students shall be required to attend at least 80% of lectures to the classes to become eligible to sit for the final examination, otherwise students will be disqualified for the same.

CANCELLATION OF SEAT

A student failing to attend classes for 30 (thirty) days at a stretch shall forfeit his seat.

ACADEMIC REGULATIONS

The college follows the regulation prepared by GU being in force from time to time in respect of concern course.

GENERAL RULES AND REGULATIONS

- Every students of the institution & all Intra-institutional bodies shall be subject to general guidance and control as may be prescribed by the College Governing body from time to time.
- No student shall be admitted to any course to studies if he or she is found to have indulged in any activity consider detrimental to academic interest.
- 3. A student shall be subject to disciplinary action if he or she is found to be disobedient or indecent in his or her behaviour with the teaching and non teaching staff.
- 4. A student who is found to have violated college rules shall be liable to expulsion.
- 5. Only recognized bodies shall have the previlege to use the college Premises after obtaining formal permission from the principal.
- 6. No notice or leaflet can be circulated any where in the College Premises without the approval of the Principal.
- 7. Each Academic Session will run as per Academic Calender embodied in the Prospectus.
- Wearing of college Uniform is compulsory during college hours on all working days including days of College Week, Meetings, Examination etc.

9. Students entering the College Compound with armed-security is illegal and subject

to disciplinary action.

- 10. Mobile Phones are strictly prohibited during class and examination hours. Any violation is subject to severe disciplinary action.
- 11. Spitting/ Smoking/ Writing on Walls, doors etc. in and around the college building is

strictly prohibited. Any student detected doing so is subject to expulsion from the college.

- 12. Ragging is strictly prohibited.
- 13. No student in any manner be involved in Ragging of any form inside the College Campus.
- 14. However, any student complained of being ragged will also be taken up by the competent authority.
- 15. Committee constituted by the Principal under his Chairmanship will be the competent authority prohibit ragging or to take any action deem fit for the greater interest for the institution.
- 16. Ragging may invite the following action to curb the menace:

Criminal offence as per law passed by a number of state government.

Rustication from the College.

Embossment on Mark-sheet, Degree Certificate etc.

Penalty and imprisonment of one year.

17. The decision of the Principal on all matters relating to students shall be final and binding.

In the event of any complaint regarding ragging on one can plead ignorance to be excused from punitive action.
